

Lesson Plans

September 18-22, 2017

This week in Reading, we will continue our character study and concentrate on the important details that help us understand our characters. Analyzing an author's craft will be introduced by discussing the things an author repeats or emphasizes in developing a character.

Writing lessons will include discussion and practice with writing leads for a story. Mentor texts will be used as examples for the students to examine. Setting and dialogue are skills that we will discuss and work to add to our previous writings.

Word sort words will feature triple letter blends such as scr, shr, sc, and sh. Words will be sent home Monday and a quiz will be given on Friday.

Social Studies discussions will be around American symbols such as the Statue of Liberty and our national anthem. We will also talk about citizenship in the U.S.

Children should be reading and recording time on their reading logs each night.
